

Literacy - Listening, Talking, Reading and Writing

This term we have had a focus on writing music reviews. We had looked at structure, subject specific vocabulary, imagery and relevant writers' tricks, whilst also discussing a range of societal issues that music artists explore through their lyrics and performances. We have also been using tabletop board games (dungeons and dragons inspired) as a means for planning our imaginative writing on Wednesdays.

Maths and Numeracy

At the request of the class, we have started this term with a recap of fractions, decimals and percentages (FDP) with a musical context. We have been drumming and writing musical notation whilst converting and calculating a range of FDP problems. Moving towards October we have been leading our own learning, revising lots of different areas from the numeracy curriculum as we prepare to engage with the SNSAs.

Other Curricular Areas

The class planned our first topic before the summer and soon you will be getting an invitation to our Sustainable Dance Festival, where pupils will be DJ-ing their own compositions and presenting their learning about the climate crisis.

Health & Wellbeing

The class have worked together to create their own class charter that links to our school values and acts as a daily reference to the positive behaviours and attitudes we hope to see in and out of the classroom. We also recently visited the Risk Factory where we learned to navigate real world dangers in a safe environment.

Home Learning

As noted above, in our bid to develop enthusiastic readers, we are strongly encouraging Primary 7 to be reading for at least twenty minutes every day. The class have, at their request, been given homework jotters so they can write one sentence daily that summarises what they have read.

Ethos & Wider Life of the School

P7 pupils who are demonstrating our school values will be chosen to act as Prefects in school. We also have Sport Captains leading lunchtime competitions and Digital Leaders helping implement our digital strategy across the school. Our school football team have new strips and continue to play on Saturdays, with more sport clubs beginning soon. Mr Minchin also hopes to offer some more music opportunities shortly.
